WHITEHAVEN SAUVIGNON BLANC

TASTING NOTES

A blend of Marlborough regions, our 2019 Whitehaven Sauvignon Blanc delivers layered, nuanced character on a refreshingly crisp palate. The wine opens with classic aromas of bright lemon, ripe tropical fruit, and fresh-snipped greens. This smooth, medium-bodied Sauvignon Blanc carries through the aromatic notes to the palate, adding hints of grapefruit, white peach, pineapple, and juicy pear. Superbly structured and balanced with a clean, zesty finish.

TASTING NOTES

A rich garnet color with a ruby edge, the wine opens to reveal lifted fruit aromas of bright strawberry and jammy fruit, mocha, and vanilla, along with toasty oak notes. Expressive boysenberry, blackberry, dark cherry, juicy strawberry, and toasty mocha flavors lend complexity and depth on the palate. The well-integrated oak provides structure and depth seldom seen in Pinot Noir.


EVERY DONATION BUILDS OUR HOUSE

HOW TO REQUEST A SONG

- 1. Find the link sent to you by text message on Tuesday, September 14th.
- 2. Click the blue link in that text.
- 3. Follow the instructions on your phone, then click "request a song" from the options.
- 4. Select a dollar amount to attach to your song request, keeping in mind that the higher the dollar amount, the quicker your song request moves to the top of the list! (All proceeds to benefit the local Ronald McDonald House.)
- 5. Enter the artist and song you want to hear & press donate.
- **6.** An "All Set" message will appear on your phone. Your request has been submitted, so get ready to dance!
- **7.** At the end of the night, your credit card on file will be charged for all song requests, as well as any additional pledges you have made.

MMMMOCKTAIL!



Here's how to make a Shirley Temple that sings.

INGREDIENTS

- 1/4 cup Sprite or Diet Sprite
- 1-1/2 tbsp. grenadine syrup
- Ice
- Maraschino cherries, whipped topping or a lime for garnish

DIRECTIONS

- Mix Sprite or Diet Sprite with grenadine syrup
- Pour over ice
- Top with cherries, whipped topping or a lime

MAKE THE PERFECT OLD FASHIONED

CLASSIC MEETS CLASS

It's been called the Granddaddy of Cocktails for good reason. Dark and boozy, a little sweet and a little bitter...is there a whiskey drink more satisfying than the Old Fashioned? (The answer is no.) It defies its stuck-in-time title, and while it's certainly been through some less-than-ideal incarnations over the years, well, who hasn't? Here's how to make an Old Fashioned that's smooth as silk.

INGREDIENTS

- 2.5 oz. Dry Fly/Lucky Lil's Rye Whiskey
- 1/2 oz. Charred Oak & Maple Syrup
- 2 dashes Black Walnut Bitters
- Boozy Cherries Garnish
- Orange Slice Garnish

DIRECTIONS

- Combine all ingredients in a mixing glass with ice and stir
- Strain into a rocks glass with a single ice sphere
- Garnish with a boozy cherry and an orange slice
